4-H RECORD BOOKS



JUNE DAIRY POSTER CONTEST

June is National Dairy Month and it's time for the 2025 dairy poster contest. Using the theme "Dairy Defenders", make a poster about the benefits of the dairy industry and dairy products. The poster must be 22 inches by 28 inches. It can be on poster board or created as an electronic submission. You can get ideas from magazines, parents, friends, Extension agents, 4-H volunteer leaders, dairy farmers, or others. Do not use brand names or copyrighted material (like cartoon characters) on your poster. The dairy poster content should be positive toward the dairy industry. Posters that slander the dairy industry are prohibited. The deadline to submit posters into the county office is Friday, June 13.
