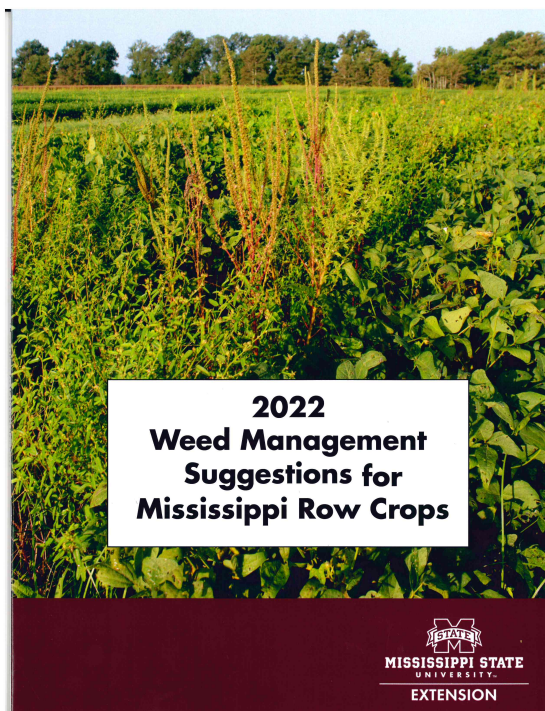

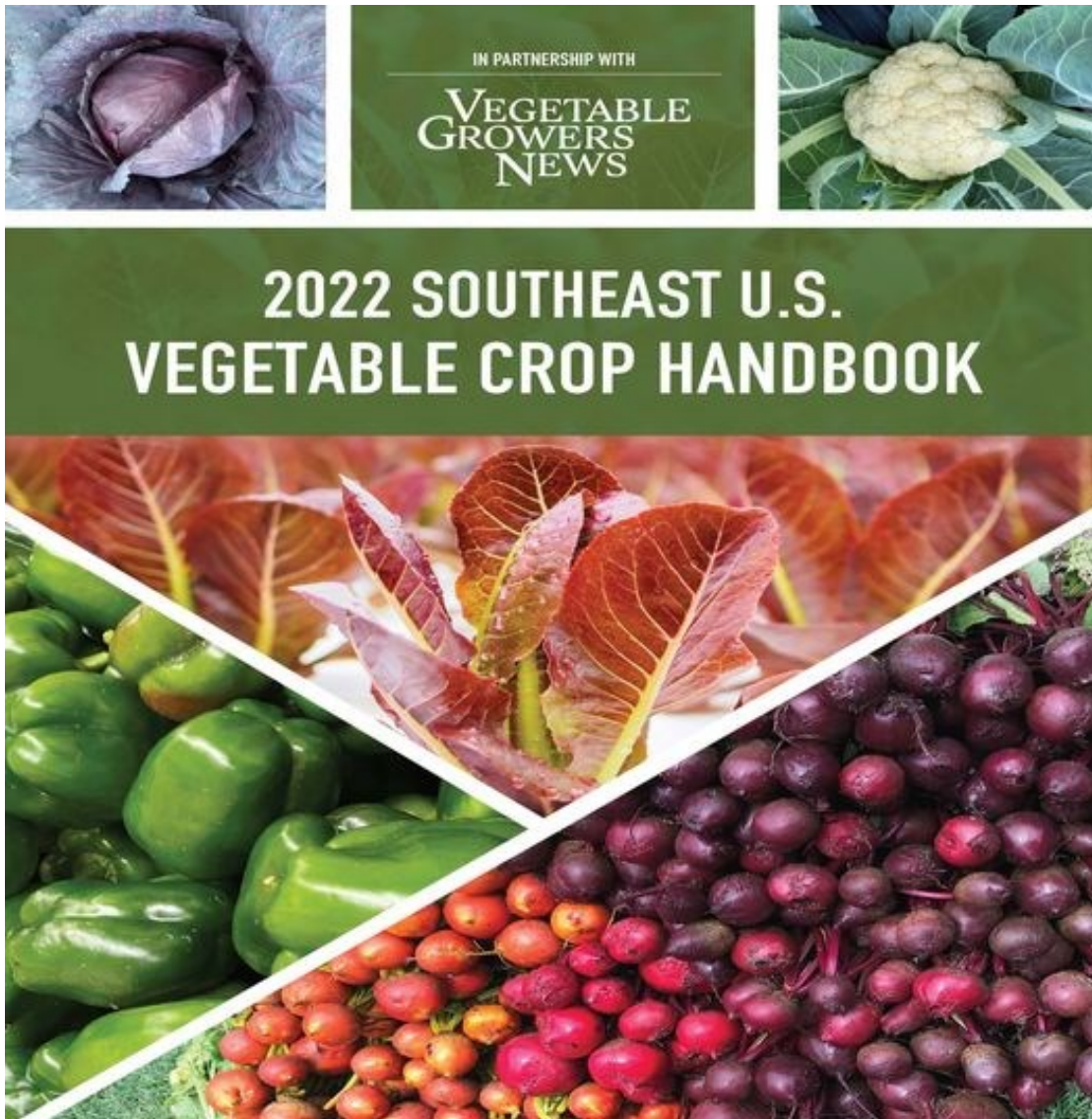
* Indicates that a variety is a "Promising Variety" and was selected based on excellent yield performance in 2021 with minimal field testing across multiple environments.
