Location of Administration <ul style="list-style-type: none"> two different vaccinations are given in the same location (-1 point) missing/incomplete information (-1 point) 	
Withdrawal <ul style="list-style-type: none"> incorrect withdrawal time listed (-0.5 point) missing/incomplete information (-1 point) 	
TSU & Ear Tags <ul style="list-style-type: none"> tags – must indicate one per ear if two administered (ex: EID & visual tag or 2 fly tags) (-0.5 point) missing/incomplete information (-1 point)

<p><u>Dewormer (10 pts.):</u> <i>Possible Point Deductions (-2 pts. each)</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fail to readminister oral product if calf spit out • Improper measure of dosage for proper applicator • Handling products labeled as hazardous without gloves <p><i>Possible Pint Deductions (-1 point each)</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Took more than 1 attempt to administer properly • Fail to apply the topical product from withers to tailhead • Fail to insert applicator of orally administered product sufficiently into mouth • Fail to wait to complete injections before applying topical product • Failure to adjust technique if corrected by official 			
<p><u>Clostridial Vaccination Injections (10 pts.):</u> <i>Possible Point Deductions (-2 pts. each)</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fail to re-administer product if not given correctly on first attempt • Shot given IM instead of SQ • Injection given behind neck, too high, too low, or too far forward • Needle used to give vaccine is same as needle use to draw vaccine • Syringe not switched between clostridial and respiratory vaccine <p><i>Possible Point Deductions (-1 point each)</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Took more than 1 attempt to administer properly • Injection not given where indicated on cattle processing plan • IM injection was given too shallow in the muscle • Wrong dose given • Needle dropped or bent 			
<p><u>Respiratory Vaccination Injections (10 pts.):</u> <i>Possible Point Deductions (-2 pts. each)</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fail to re-administer product if not given correctly on first attempt • Shot given IM instead of SQ • Injection given behind neck, too high, too low, or too far forward • Needle used to give vaccine is same as needle use to draw vaccine • Vaccine not properly hydrated • Syringe not switched between clostridial and respiratory vaccine <p><i>Possible Point Deductions (-1 point each)</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Took more than 1 attempt to administer properly • Injection not given where indicated on cattle processing plan • IM injection was given too shallow in the muscle • Wrong dose given • Needle dropped or bent 			

<p><u>Tags: (10 pts)</u> Possible Point Deductions: (-2 each) • Fly Tags handled without gloves Possible Point Deductions (-1 each)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Took more than 1 attempt to administer properly • Ear tag not placed in two ears per instructions on bag • Ear button in contact with implant (may be subject to owners' decision) • Tag placed in ear backwards (unless placed here to avoid blocking visual tag) • Tag not placed in location specified on cattle processing plan • Tag not placed securely or correctly in ear <p>Other Deductions:</p>			
<p><u>Implants (10 pts.):</u> Possible Point Deductions (-2 pts. each)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Implant deposited in a cluster • Needle run through the ear and implant falling to the ground • Implant not palpable on the back of the ear in a SQ location • Implant not inserted in correct location <p>Possible Point Deductions (-1 point each)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Implant is in contact with button on ear tag • Failure to disinfect implant gun between calves <p>Other Deductions:</p>			
<p><u>Cattle Handling (10 pts.):</u> Possible Point Deductions (-2 pts. each)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rough Handling • Failure to use crowd gate • Excessive use of cattle stick <p>Possible Point Deductions (-1 point each)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Team needed more than 1 attempt to properly load cattle into alley chute • Noisy handling • Missed head catch • Failure to use squeeze before processing • Failure to release squeeze before releasing animal • Failure to latch crowd gate • Failure to use bar behind animal • Failure to remove bar after releasing animal when gate opens for the next animal <p>Other Deductions:</p>
