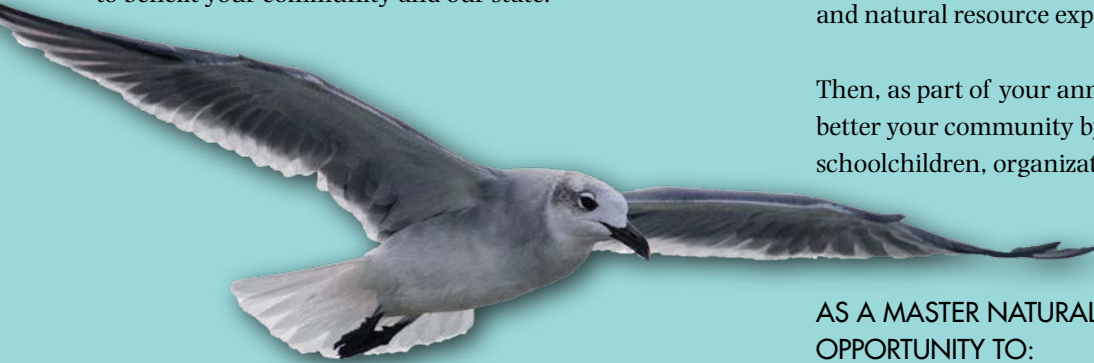
BECOME A MISSISSIPPI MASTER NATURALIST!
